

COMMITTEES OF THE PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

The Committees play a very important role and contribute to the more rational and efficient work of the Houses. The House of Peoples has three standing committees, the House of Representatives has seven standing committees, and both Houses have six joint committees. The committees were formed according to the areas of responsibility of the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, so that their organization follows the relevant organizational structure of the Ministries in the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

This enables direct parliamentary control of the work of the Ministries and the implementation of laws according to the competencies of the relevant Ministry. Draft laws and other Acts, which are subject to the consideration of the Houses, are first considered by the relevant committees, which then provide the Houses with their reports and opinions on compatibility with the Constitution and the legal system of Bosnia and Herzegovina; ensuring that the principles of proposed laws and amendments to laws that are put into the consideration and adoption procedure are harmonized with the applicable legislation. The competent committee considers the amendments to the draft law and, once adopted, the amendments become an integral part of the draft law subject to consideration by the House. The committees may decide to discuss the proposed laws, conduct hearings and request reports from any elected or appointed official, officer or institution.
